Correction of political survey

even though the interviewing classes have completed their work with it.

"In developing and giving the questionnaire to candidates, certain problems came up concerning some of the questions," says Connors. "Some of the questions were a bit rough and were not as clear as we would have liked. Brannon will take the questionnaire and analyze it in the light of the comments of the candidates and the students." Brannon's results will be

published in a professional paper.

According to Connors, the project has taught the class and himself much about the "political mind."

"Even though many of the questions called for simple yes, no or no comment answers, most of the candidates could not resist the opportunity to expand on their answers," Connors says.
