Purpose of the Study: The Justice Center developed a crime victimization survey compatible with Sawtooth Technologies' Ci3 survey writing software and WinCati computer-assisted telephone interview (CATI) software. In addition, the Center produced an SPSS syntax file allowing users to transform data collected using the victimization survey.

Transformations: The Ci3 software program is able to export collected data in multiple formats including SPSS .sav files. Even if the data are exported as an SPSS file, they still lack meaningful name labels and value labels. Therefore, an SPSS syntax file (.sps) was developed which transforms the Ci3 exported data file, combining variables, assigning variable names and value labels, and reducing the overall size of the data set. The codebook describes variables and labels post-transformation; variables and labels will not be consistent with the SPSS .sav file unless the user runs the syntax file (see instructions on page 2).

Important Note: Changes to either the Ci3 programming or the SPSS syntax file may result in changes to the codebook. The user should be aware of all implications of any changes.

Instructions for Transforming Variables

- 1. Open the survey in Ci3. From the file menu, select choose export and data and labels.
- 2. A new window will appear. Select SPSS from the export format drop-down box.
- 3. On the specifications tab, you will see a list of all variables in the dataset. Make sure all of the variables are marked with an 'X' except the following:
 - Variables with an open-end format
 - All variables following the CPEnd variable (CPEnd is approximately 12 variables from the bottom of the list).
- 4. Click the export data button. The data will export (a window will show you the number of respondents processed). The procedure could take several minutes depending upon the number of respondents in the dataset.
- 5. Close *Ci3*.
- 6. Open SPSS. Load the file exported in steps 1-5 above.
- 7. Open the syntax file SPSS Syntax Conversion included on the project CD-Rom.
- 8. Highlight all of the syntax (easily accomplished by pressing Ctrl+A simultaneously). Once the text is highlighted, click on the run button. The transformations will begin. The process could take up to an hour depending upon computer processor and memory and the number of respondents.
- 9. After the transformations are complete, a file will appear in the SPSS data window entitled CVS_survey. Save this file to a location of your choosing (feel free to rename the file if you wish).
- 10. The transformed file is not complete with variable labels, value labels, etc.

*160a What ended it?

*160a is asked of respondents answer choice 2 (no) in question *160.
